**Stratford College** is pleased to offer students the opportunity to study for **The Jerusalem Examination in optional after- school classes (additional fees will apply)**

The Jerusalem Examination is the highest test of Hebrew and Jewish Knowledge designed specifically for the Diaspora. It is intended for Graduates of Jewish High Schools and other students of Hebrew who want a recognized official record of their achievements.

The Examination consists of two sections: The first tests the student's knowledge of literary sources from all Periods of the Hebrew language. The second section tests the student's knowledge of Hebrew through Comprehension of an "unseen" passage, writing a short composition and completing grammar exercises

## **What credit does the candidate receive?**

The Jerusalem Examination provides the student with a framework for serious, in-depth, fundamental learning. The Hebrew University in Jerusalem, together with the Jewish Agency, awards the Jerusalem Diploma to every candidate who passes the Examination. This diploma exempts its holder from the Hebrew courses for overseas students offered by universities in Israel. It is thus recognized by all Israeli institutes of higher learning. Some universities abroad give credits for the diploma.

Students who enrol in this class should be proficient in Modern Hebrew and must be 16 years of age or over to sit the exam. Preparation will typically take up to 3 years.

After school classes will begin in January subject to demand\*. Please see below for more information including fees.

Beginners Hebrew Classes will continue as normal.
