Well Being: Disconnect to Reconnect

There is a lot being written about our teenagers mental health and we are certainly experiencing higher levels of anxiety than ever before. The Irish Times recently published an **article** about questioning children's usage of smart phones (31st March 2024).

In it there is a reference to the *Anxious Generation* and references **Jonathan Haidt's new book** of the same name. His website **anxiousgeneration.com** has a section for parent resources which you might find interesting.

As you know our Well Being theme is 'Disconnect to Reconnect'. The National Education Psychologists Service (NEPS) has recently videographed our Well Being Team (teachers and students) about our work in this area as an example of best practice. We will share this with you when we receive it ourselves.

We are also part of a research study led by **DCU Anti Bullying Centre** which is examining the effectiveness of our phone-away boxes and parents support of our policies.

Also as part of our theme we introduced a module called **Boys to Men** for our male students and Leadership training through the **LIFT** programme. We are also looking at empathy training for students through **Narrative**.

In support of our work in this area our Parents Association (PA) will be hosting Stuart Wilson from **zestlife.ie**. Our PA will be in touch with further details. We hope as many parents as possible will support this important event.
