#### **Assessment is Changing**

Stratford has been buzzing with all sorts of assessments for the last couple of months. Read on and click on the links for more details:

### Standardised Testing

1st Years have completed their **Group Reading Test** (GRTs) in reading and **Cognitive Ability Tests** (CATs). Results of the latter will be sent home to parents with the June Reports.

2nd Years have sat the **Drumcondra On-Line Testing System** (DOTs) in reading and maths. The results of these will be sent home with the June Reports.

#### State Exams Commission

3rd and 6th Years have completed **project** work in Science, Art, CSPE, and orals in Irish and French. Leaving Certificate students have submitted their projects in History, Geography, Art and practicals in Music.

**New assessments** in Junior Cycle for 2nd Years (Science, Business and English) and 3rd Year English are on-going since December. The 2nd Year Classroom Based Assessment (CBAs) descriptors will be included in students June Reports and in the **Junior Certificate Student Award** (JCSA) after 3rd Year.

#### Grading

There are **new grades** for both Junior and Leaving Certificates.

Orals

All classes are doing language orals and TY and 5th Year participated in Irish orals for adults (**TEG**) and French (**DELF**)

Public Speaking

1st Years did public speaking exams run by the **Leinster School of Music and Drama**. Results will be included with the June Reports. TYs took part in Toastmasters exams earlier this term.

English as an Additional Language (EAL) exams **Preliminary English Test** (PET) for Schools by Cambridge
