This is recognised not just by our students and families, but also in the manner by which a number of our teachers are involved in national curriculum development, assessment and quality assurance.


Stratford College will continue to 'Honour the past, value the present and commit to the future'.


Stratford past pupil (2019) awarded Trinity College Dublin Entrance Exhibition
